ROLLCALL 87: Dental Laboratory Technicians (Chapter 6), Table 1

11 Apprentice Dental *Mechanics* were included in error in the Apprentice category for Dental Laboratory *Technicians*.

ROLLCALL 89: Dental Laboratory Technicians (Chapter 6), Table 1

Data for *On-permit* personnel were incorrectly labelled *Apprentice*;
Data for *Apprentice* personnel were incorrectly labelled *On-permit*.

A programming error resulted in the distribution of personnel into incorrect Regional Hospital Districts.
