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ERRATA: ROLLCALL 91 AND ROLLCALL UPDATE 92

While preparing tables for publication in *ROLLCALL 93*, a number of processing errors in data reported in previous *ROLLCALL* publications became evident. The publications, the personnel groups for which data were reported in error, the tables affected, and the nature of the errors are as follows:

***ROLLCALL 91:* Dentists (Chapter 6), Tables 1-5**

On all tables there was an error in calculation which resulted in the inclusion of a number of dentists whose records were deleted in the data received from the College of Dental Surgeons of British Columbia.

On Table 5 there was also an allocation error between the "Reactivation" and "New Registrant" categories.

Pharmacists (Chapter 21), Tables 1-5

On all tables there was an error in calculation which resulted in exclusion of several pharmacists who had B.C. addresses at the date of record.

The age/sex table (Table 2) also had an error in the calculation of the "< 25" age group.

The analysis of change table (Table 5) also included a programming error in the "Reactivations" and "New Registrants" columns.

Community Pharmacies (Appendix D), Table 1

An error in calculation resulted in the inclusion of a number of pharmacies which were not in operation.
