

PETITION TO UNIVERSITY LABOUR COMMITTEE re: NEGOTIATIONS
WITH A.U.C.E. LOCAL #1

Library and clerical workers at UBC are grossly underpaid. This injustice is felt even more by those workers in the lower classifications. The University's proposed wage increase, ranging from \$38 for the lowest paid to \$82 for the highest paid workers, does not in any real sense increase these workers' wages, and only amplifies the division between the highest and lowest paid workers.

Over 90% of these workers are women. The University's proposal clearly reflects an unfair attitude towards female staff. Therefore, we the undersigned, strongly urge the University Administration to reconsider its wage proposal to A.U.C.E. Local #1, and to offer a proposal more in line with the University's role as a leader in the community.
