After the Union received your letter dated May 24, 1980, a sub-committee of three people from our Executive was struck to investigate the allegations you made against Marcel Dionne. These three people talked with AUCE members in the Copy & Duplicating department as well as AUCE members from the Registrar's Office, July Blair and Marcel Dionne. It was the conclusion of this committee that Marcel was guilty, by his actions, of counselling AUCE members to perform scab labour.

A letter of censure went out to him along with a request that he resign from the position of President of Local 1. He sent a letter of resignation that same day and nominations will be open at our union meeting this month for that position.

The Executive unanimously felt Marcel's actions were inappropriate to that of a President of our Union and we appreciate your bringing those actions to our attention.
