

MOTIONS PASSED RE: SECESSION PROCEDURES AT FEB 26 & 27/82 PROVINCIAL EXECUTIVE MEETING

- 1) That for the Purposes of Section 6A of the Provincial Constitution an inquiry shall be set up to:
 - 1) Explore fully the basis on which the petition has been forwarded;
 - 2) To make sure that the Membership of the Local has been given a fair opportunity to discuss the issues surrounding the proposed secession.
- 2) That the Provincial Executive develop a policy on secession that is non specific to locals.
- 3) That we adopt the following as constituting the nature of an inquiry.
That an inquiry may consist of the following steps:
 - 1) A meeting with the Local Executive;
 - 2) meeting(s) with local stewards;
 - 3) informal meetings with local members;
 - 4) a questionnaire to be sent to each member;
 - 5) a formal General Membership Meeting chaired by the Provincial Executive.
- 4) That at its discretion, the Provincial Executive may omit any one of steps one to five.
- 5) That a sub-committee of the Provincial Executive be struck to conduct an inquiry into Local 4's request for secession according to Section 6A of the Provincial Constitution and that we call for volunteers to serve on it.
- 6) That members of Local 4 not be part of the investigatory committee set up to investigate Local 4's request for secession.
