I observe that the returns of precipitation  
from your station for the following months have not come  
to hand.

December 1913, March, June, July, August  
and September, 1914.

The meteorological year ends on September  
30th and I shall be obliged if you will be good enough  
to forward the required information at your early conven-  
ience so that the annual records may be made up.

The Provincial Government have established  
eighty stations during the last fourteen months, many  
being in the far interior, and it is considered that the  
information thus being accumulated will prove extremely  
valuable in the future.
