Paul Bennett was brought before Mr. McMullin, S.M. yesterday charged with supplying an intoxicant to Stephen Campbell an Indian at the Skeena River on the 29th of August, 1916. Bennett pleaded guilty and was fined \$50.00 or 2 months hard labour in the Common Gaol at Prince Rupert.
