Sir.-

Mr McMullin informs me he wrote to you about getting the snow cleared off the bridges at Port Essington, and wished you to get it done, I am told the snow is very heavy on the bridges, & if it is not cleared off before rain sets in it is likely to brake them down, I think it adviseable to get this done without delay, the rate of wages paid for read work is \$3.50 per day, when you have get this work done please make out account for each man on a seperate voucher, get him to sign it as paid, & certify to it yourself, & forward it to the Government Agent, Prince Rupert.
