Re: Unlawful removal of Land Surveyors Marks

Complaints have come from the Lands Department, that Municipal, as well as other people, in building roads very often removes the Surveyors marks.

Under section 532 of the Criminal Code you will see that this is a Criminal and therefore an Indictable Offence.

You are hereby requested to keep on the alert, and whenever you find sufficient evidence in contravention of this section, you will at once notify me, giving full particulars and then proceed immediately with a prosecution against the guilty party or parties.
