An Act to enlarge the Time limited by "The Harewood Railway Company Act, 1864," for making and completing a Railway from Departure Bay, Nanaimo District, to the Harewood Coal Fields, in Mountain District, Vancouver Island.
[15th February, 1866.]

WHEREAS, by the Second Section of "The Harewood Railway Company Act, 1864," it is enacted that the Company shall, within Two Years from the Passage of the said Act, unless hindered by the Dangers of the Seas or other Unavoidable Casualty, make and complete the Permanent Way of the said Line from a Point marked A to another Point marked B, on the Map marked No. 1, deposited in the Land Office, and there recorded by the Surveyor General, with a Single Line of Rails at the Least of a Guage not exceeding Six Feet Two Inches, with all Necessary Sidings and other Works convenient for the Public Traffic of the Line. Preamble.

And whereas the said Harewood Railway Company Act, 1864, finally passed into Law on the 7th day of July, 1864 ;

And whereas it is expedient to extend the Period within which the said Company shall make and complete the said Permanent Way of the said Line : Be it therefore enacted by the Governor, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Vancouver Island and its Dependencies, as follows :
