The Committee of the Privy Council have had before them a report dated January 7th, 1955, from the Minister of Justice, stating that, with the assistance of the legal officers of his Department, he has examined the Statutes of the Province of British Columbia passed at the session of the Legislative Assembly that commenced on the 16th day of February, 1954, and closed on the 14th day of April, 1954, and received by the Secretary of State of Canada on the 17th day of August, 1954, and that he is of opinion that these Statutes may be left to such operation as they may have.

The Committee concur in the foregoing and advise that a copy hereof be transmitted to the Lieutenant-Governor of the Province of British Columbia for the information of his Government.
