Whereas the Minister of Justice reports that with the assistance of the legal officers of his Department he has examined the statutes of the Province of British Columbia passed at the Third Session of the Twenty-ninth Legislative Assembly of the Legislature and received by the Secretary of State of Canada on the Tenth day of October, 1972, and is of the opinion that these statutes may be left to such operation as they may have.
