Heron, Mrs. Bessie (Vanderhoof), from the estate of Mrs. Heron's father, the late John Henry Sewell:

- (a) A collection of more than three thousand artifacts from prehistoric sites in the Vanderhoof area and other parts in central and northern British Columbia.
- (b) A collection of stone mauls and other archaeological specimens from sites in the vicinity of Saskatoon, Saskatchewan.
- (c) A collection of Lower and Upper Palaeolithic stone implements from various sites in Europe.
- (d) A comprehensive series of stone implements fashioned by Mr. Sewell, illustrating a variety of stone-flaking techniques.
- (e) The complete set of percussion and pressure flaking tools made and employed by Mr. Sewell in conducting his experiments and research in stone working techniques.
