



# WARRANT OF COMMITMENT

ON SUMMARY CONVICTION

CANADA.  
PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA,  
COUNTY OF WESTMINSTER,  
CITY OF NEW WESTMINSTER,  
To Wit.

To all or any of the Constables and other Peace Officers in the said City of New Westminster, and to the Keeper of the Common Gaol of the District of New Westminster, at New Westminster, in said Province.

Whereas **One Lung** (pleaded guilty) <sup>late of</sup> was this day at and in the City of New Westminster aforesaid, duly convicted before the undersigned, **H. L. Edmonds Esq.** Police Magistrate ~~and one of His Majesty's Justices of the Peace in and for the said City of New Westminster, for that~~

**he the said One Lung at the City of New Westminster on the 16th. day of October A. D. 1911**  
**did unlawfully steal a quantity of brass from the British Columbian Electric Railway Company of a less value than Ten Dollars**

contrary to the form of the Statute in such case made and provided. And it was thereby adjudged that the said **One Lung** for **his** said offence should be imprisoned in the Common Gaol at New Westminster, in the said Province, and there kept at hard labor for the term of **Three Months**

These are therefore to command you, the said Constables or Peace Officers, or any of you, to take the said **One Lung** and him safely to convey to the Common Gaol at New Westminster aforesaid, and there to deliver him to the said keeper thereof, together with this precept; and I do hereby command you, the said Keeper of the said Common Gaol, to receive the said

**One Lung** into your custody, in the said Common Gaol, there to imprison him and keep him at hard labor for the term of **Three Months**

and for your so doing this shall be your sufficient warrant.
