

PERJURY PROVED IN LIQUOR CASE

After a trial lasting all day, Alex le Bortoli was found guilty at the fall assizes Wednesday of perjury, arising from evidence given by him in a liquor selling charge heard before Magistrate Findlay in local police court. Bortoli was charged on three counts and the jury found him guilty on one of these.

A true bill was returned against John Anchan, charged with causing greivous bodily harm, in connection with the death of his wife. Anchan was originally charged with murder but this charge was reduced by the crown.

On the charge of importing and being in unlawful possession of drugs, true bills were returned in the cases of Lin Fong Duck, Wong Wing and Tchung Mee.
