

# CHARGES OF CONSPIRACY AGAINST FOUR

Customs and Police Make  
Raids Here and at  
Victoria. *Oct. 14,

## SPEEDBOATS ARE SEIZED

---

Investigation of Narcotic  
Ring About to Be  
Revealed.

At 3 o'clock this afternoon Frank Marino, 1723 Keefer street, was taken into custody on a charge of conspiracy.

---

**O**PERATIONS of a narcotic ring on an extended scale are to be revealed in court, it is believed, following raids made this morning by Special Officer Norman deGraves of the Canadian customs, and a squad of customs officers and Royal Canadian Mounted Police acting under special warrants.

Raids were carried out simultaneously in Vancouver and Victoria and arrests made under charges of conspiracy. Two speed boats were seized in Vancouver harbor.

### FOUR ARE IN CUSTODY.

Raids in Vancouver were made on the premises of Gin Lee Yuen, 75 Pender street east, and Yuen Fat Wah Jung Company, 236 Pender street east. At the former address Lim Gin and Wong Lai Tong were placed under arrest while at the latter address Sing Lee was taken into custody. At Victoria Dominic Cristofi was arrested.

The speed boats seized here were the Dynamite of Vancouver and the MI68 of Seattle.

### DISCLOSURES EXPECTED.

While Officer deGraves refused to make any comment on the arrests, it is known that the activities of the officers have to do with an alleged narcotic ring. The investigation has been under way for some time, and it is understood that sensational disclosures are to be made when the cases
