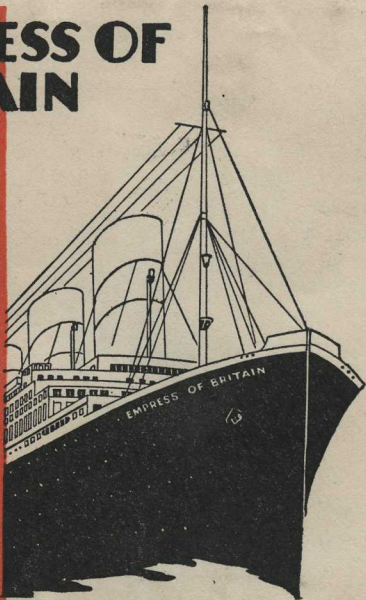

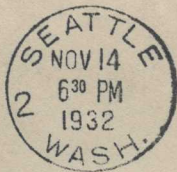

Dear Mr. Hergert:


We are in receipt of your letter of November 11th together with memorandum giving particulars of tickets you purchased and receipt from the Lethbridge Agent.
