Since writing to you on January 30, I have received a copy of the recently published "The Story of the Rockefeller Foundation", written by Mr Raymond Fosdick. From it I gather that Mr Embree did serve as secretary of the Foundation from 1917 to 1924 but that early in 1925 "a Division of Studies had been created under Edwin R. Embree to which were assigned several miscellaneous interests, including the training of nurses ...". Mrs Norma S. Thompson succeeded Mr Embree as secretary in 1925 and continued to hold that position until 1947.

This seems to clear up the point at issue quite nicely.
