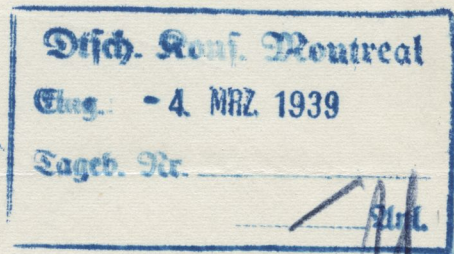


I beg to advise you that the following changes
