RE AUSTRALIAN TRADE AGREEMENT, 1931.

By Order in Council (P.C. 3053), dated the 10th December, 1937, as amended by Order in Council (P.C. 91), dated the 12th January, 1938, passed under the authority of Section 4 of the Australian Trade Agreement Act, 1931, and Section 11 of the Customs Tariff, it is ordered that the Tariff advantages conceded in Article 1 of the Australian Trade Agreement, 1931, shall apply, effective on and after the 1st October, 1937, in the special cases where goods are shipped from Australia to Canada on a through bill of lading and the Australian Government certifies that direct shipment to Canada of such goods is not reasonably practicable.
