MONTHLY REPORT

SILVER, LEAD and ZINC PRODUCTION IN CANADA - OCTOBER, 1938.

<u>SILVER</u> - The Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa reports that the Canadian output of silver in October amounted to 1,774,446 ounces compared with 1,680,722 ounces in the preceding month and 2,042,044 ounces in October, 1937. Production during the first ten months of the current year totalled 18,878,000 ounces; this represented a decline of 5.4 per cent from the output a year ago.

The average price of silver on the New York market (Handy & Harman) in October was 43.149 cents per ounce in Canadian funds; based on this price the Canadian output during the month was worth \$765,656. In September silver averaged 43.022 cents per ounce and the value of the month's output was \$723,080.

Exports of silver bullion from Canada during October advanced to 1,610,671 ounces from the September total of 708,555 ounces. The silver content of ores, concentrates, etc., exported during the month was 950,696 ounces as against 877,249 ounces in the previous month.

Silver bullion imports in October rose to 352,320 ounces worth \$149,411; during September, 109,270 ounces at \$44,119 were imported. The October importations were obtained from the United States.

Silver production in the United States during October amounted to 5,441,000 ounces compared with 5,073,000 ounces in the preceding month. The Peruvian output declined to 1,800,000 ounces from the September total of 1,875,000 ounces.

LEAD - Lead production in Canada during October amounted to 38,556,576 pounds; in the preceding month, 35,680,581 pounds were produced while in October, 1957, the output was 40,632,503 pounds. During the ten months ending October, Canada produced 358,024,275 pounds of lead compared with 351,985,133 pounds, a year ago.

Quotations for lead on the London market in October averaged 3.462 cents per pound, in Canadian funds; valued at this price the output during the month was worth 1,534,822. The average price in September was 3.295 cents per pound and the value of the month's output was \$1,174,962.

An increase of 25.7 per cent was recorded in the exports of pig lead from Canada in October compared with the September exportations; the totals were 34,841,200 pounds and 27,714,800 pounds, respectively. The lead content of ores, concentrates, etc., exported in October amounted to 1,448,300 pounds; in the preceding month the lead content totalled 2,073,800 pounds.

The American Bureau of Metal Statistics estimates the world output of refined lead at 155,745 tons in October, or 4.4 per cent above the September total. In the United States, 27,968 tons were produced from domestic ores; stocks declined 15,877 tons during the month to 117,476 tons. Mexico produced 19,408 tons as against 21,615 tons in September. The Australian output of refined lead (including lead refined in Great Britain) totalled 21,237 tons; in September, 22,917 tons were produced.

ZINC - The Canadian output of zinc in October totalled 29,188,430 pounds compared with 29,415,685 pounds in the preceding month and 37,251,611 pounds in October, 1937. Production during the ten months ending October aggregated 314,406,360 pounds or 1.3 per cent above the output of a year ago.

The average price of zinc on the London market in October was 3.228 cents per pound, in Canadian funds; the September average price was lower at 3.027 cents. Based on these prices, the October and September outputs were worth \$942,203 and \$890,413, respectively.

An increase of 40.9 per cent was recorded in the exports of zinc spelter during October when 28,819,000 pounds were shipped from Canada against 20,459,600 pounds in the previous month. No zinc concentrates were exported during October; in the preceding month exports amounted to 2,925,700 pounds.

The world output of zinc in October advanced to 142,641 tons or 4,601 tons per day from the September total of 131,931 tons or a daily average of 4,398 tons. In the United States production increased 13.6 per cent to 36,740 tons while shipments totalled 43,355 tons with the result that stocks at the end of the month were 6,615 tons lower at 124,128 tons.
