We have your letter of the 17th. Instant,  
and note your remarks about the shipment of Chain Hoists that  
we imported from Gebr. Bolzani, G.m.b.h.

We would like to point out that in the  
first place we wrote to the manufacturers in Germany, asking  
for prices on Chain Hoists, and after receiving these, we then  
placed an order with the above concern. If they were quoting  
us a lower price than the Fair Market Value, then we believe  
they should have advised us at the time so that we could have  
figured exactly what these chain hoists would cost us laid down  
here. We were not aware of any difference in price until we  
received their invoice.

It just happened that the shipment was  
sent to us and received prior to the ruling of April 27th.,  
1937, on the Reichsmarks. Therefore, in future when we are  
purchasing material from Germany we believe it would be better  
for us to find out the Fair Market Value as sold for Home Con-  
sumption, as well as the price they quote us, because we are  
continually running into this trouble. Just recently we  
cleared a shipment of sample Chain Hoists from Gebruder Kerner  
of Suhl, and we had dumping duty amounting to \$13.00 to pay on  
this shipment which was only a small one.

The writer will be very glad to talk the  
matter over further with you when you come to Toronto.
