In reply to your inquiry of November 17th, re the duty on writing pads in Germany, I regret to say that I am not in a position to give authentic information with regard to the classification of individual commodities for customs purposes. Wilgress, Hamburg 1, Raboisen 8, sending him at the same time a sample of the goods in question, in order that he may be able to obtain the desired information from the competent German authorities.
