AGE CERTIFICATES FOR IMPORTED WHISKEY OR BRANDY

By Order in Council (P.C. 814) dated 25th April, 1938, the regulation relating to the importation of intoxicating liquors, commonly known as whiskey, brandy or rum, was amended by deleting therefrom the words "Whiskey, Brandy or Rum" where they occur in the said regulation, and inserting in lieu thereof the words "Whiskey or Brandy".

The effect of the above is that the production of an age certificate in respect of rum will no longer be necessary.
