Dear Mr. Warren,-

I wrote a short time since to the Commissioner of Fisheries for Oregon, asking if he could favor me with some of the reports that have been issued and he very kindly sent me the reports for 1917, 1918 and 1919.

I notice in looking over same that you were on the Commission and it occurred to me you might possibly have spare copies of some of the old reports which I lack. These are the reports covering the years 1907-8, 1911-12 and 1913-14, so if it is possible to secure copies of same, I would appreciate it greatly, as I have the Oregon Reports back to the first ones issued with the exception of the three mentioned above.

I note in the reports that cover the last three years, that these do not contain the statistics as to pack, etc., which earlier reports showed. If these statistics were published separately, I would like if possible to secure them as well.

We are having quite a discussion here as to the efficiency of artificial propagation with the Sockeye Species. Quite a few of the packers are agitating to have all hatchery operations discontinued as the results shown have been not very satisfactory, while others of us are in favor of additional efforts being
