Dear Whitehead;-

For your information I enclose herewith copy of Jarvis's reply to my letter of the 17th ulto. I am not answering this as I agree with him that further correspondence will not get us anywhere.

Needless to say the incidents I referred to concerning lack of organization and dissatisfaction were incidents of recent origin and not those that happened in previous years.

I do not pretend to be an expert accountant and concerning the 1927 losses only gave the figures shown in the Balance Sheet itself and in the Auditors remarks thereon. If the Auditors were wrong, as Jarvis's statement would indicate, their remarks certainly appear to have no other interpretation than the one I took from them.

If Jarvis is under the impression that I was in any way connected with what the Vancouver Financial News printed he is mistaken. I had never even heard of that publication until myb attention was directed to their article in the issue of March 30th.
