Dear Mr. Read;-

I enclose herewith copy of a letter I wrote Mr. Royal of the International E.S.F. Commission to-day in acknowledging receipt of Bulletin LV of its publications which he had kindly sent me. I think copy of this letter might be added to what I previously sent you in defence of my position.

Since 20th June when I sent back to you my King Salmon manuscript I have heard nothing from you, and indeed nothing since your letter of 9th May. The delay however, may make advisable some changes in the text to bring the statistics and what they portend up to date but I do not wish to start on this until I know definitely whether your Council accepts or rejects the manuscript.
