Dear Jarvis:-

Pardon the delay in sending you the enclosed, but knowing you were going to New York before returning to Toronto I thought there was no particular hurry, so did not work out the figures as quickly as I might have done.

By the percentage table you will observe that while the B. C. F. & P. Co continue to slip back, even with the addition of the B. C. Canning Co and the Wallace Fisheries plants, the Gosse Packing Co and the Canadian Fishing Co continue to gain steadily on your company on all grades of fish. Even with your acquisitions your percentages - excepting Chums - are lower than your three companies averaged in 1916-1923 while both Gosse and Hager increased their packs to a greater extent than the B. C. Canning Co and Wallace have added to yours.

When we were lunching together the other day you mentioned you had a copy of Gosse's annual report and balance sheet. Can you get me a copy of same? I aim to make my records as complete as possible and would be glad to have this to add to my dossier on the Gosse company.
