The Bankruptcy Act 1861

In the matter of the Petition for  
adjudication against Robert Watson  
and George Watson trading under the  
name of Watson and Company  
Bankrupts

Street Victoria Vancouver Island Manager  
of the Firm of Anderson and Company Merchants of  
Victoria aforesaid make oath and say that the  
said Robert Watson and George Watson were at and  
before the filing of the said Petition and still assets  
and truly indebted to me this deponent on behalf of  
the Firm of Anderson and Company in the sum of  
Four Thousand Two hundred and Nine Dollars  
for goods sold and delivered by the said Firm for  
which said sum of Four Thousand Two hundred and Nine Dollars  
or any part thereof I this deponent say that I have  
not nor has the said Firm nor any Person by my Order  
or on account of the said Firm or to my knowledge  
or belief for my use or for the use of the said Firm  
had or received any manner of satisfaction or security

Whatsoever except a certain Mortgage executed by Robert  
Watson and George Watson and his brother for the sum of  
Sworn at Victoria in the Colony  
of Vancouver Island this  
day of December 28 1865 Before me  
I am at Victoria Vancouver Island  
the day of January 4 1866
