1. That three fourths in value of my
creditors have executed the deed of assignment
hereto annexed marked A which is a deed
of assignment of all my property estate

the benefit of my creditors
2. That the assets comprised in such deed
consist of a lease of an unexpired term of
5 years of about 8 acres of land adjoining
Beacon Hill subject to a rent of \$42⁵⁰ per
annum. and 8 head of stock 4 pigs and
some furniture which are of the estimated
value of \$350 or thereabouts subject to a
mortgage in favor of James Ward for \$600⁰⁰
which said mortgage is now due.
