of British Columbia and that previous to
their commencing business as Contractors as
aforesaid they both resided within the juris-
diction of this Honorable Court that is to say
at Victoria Vancouver Island and are jointly
indebted to your petitioner in the sum of six
hundred and fifty eight Dollars and fifteen
cents lawful currency And that your
Petitioner has been informed and verily
believes that the said Thomas Mann and
Malcolm Munro did lately commit an
act of Bankruptcy within the true intent
and meaning of the Law of Bankruptcy
Your Petitioner therefore humbly
prays:

That upon proof of the requisites
in that behalf adjudication ^{of said petition} may
be made against the said Thomas
Mann and Malcolm Munro
