The Bankrupt Law Consolidation Act 1849

March 7 A.D. 1867.

Whereas by evidence duly taken upon
oath, it hath been made to appear to the
satisfaction of me, the undersigned
Matthew Baillie Peffie Judge of the
Supreme Court of Civil Justice Acting in
Bankruptcy, and Acting in the prosecution
of a petition for adjudication of bankruptcy
filed and now in prosecution against
James Jackson Evans Ephraim Thomson
Evans, Joseph Lamett Evans & David Shaw
Evans of British Columbia Dealers &
Chapmen and bearing date the
26th January 1867 and under which
the said James Jackson Evans, Ephraim
Thomson Evans, Joseph Lamett Evans
& David Shaw Evans have been adjudged
bankrupt, that there is reason to
suspect and believe that ~~the~~
property of the said James Jackson
Evans Ephraim Thomson Evans Joseph

in Victoria in that part of British Columbia

of the said act.
