I the said Chief Justice upon good proof
upon oath before me this day taken do find
that the said Paris Carter became bankrupt
within the true intent and meaning of the
law of bankruptcy before the day of the
date of the filing of the said petition by
him and I do therefore declare and adjudge
him bankrupt accordingly.
