NOTICE.—If you are desirous of confessing the Plaintiff's claim, you must deliver your confession to the Registrar of the Court five clear days before the day of appearing to this summons; but you may enter your confession at any time before the day of appearing, subject to the payment of further costs.

If you and the Plaintiff can agree as to the amount due and the mode of payment, judgment may at any time before the Court day be entered by the Registrar of the Court. In which case you and the plaintiff must attend at the Registrar's office for that purpose, and no attendence by either of you will be necessary at the Court.

If you admit the whole or any part of the Plaintiff's demand, by paying into the office of the Registrar of the Court at the Court House to the amount so admitted, together with the costs, proportionate to the amount you pay in, five clear dayr before the day of appearance, you will avoid any further costs, unless in case of part payment, the Plantiff, at the hearing, shall prove a demand against you exceeding the sum so paid into Court.

If you intend to rely on as a detence, a set-off, infancy, coverture, or a statute of limitations, you must give notice thereof to the Registrar of the Court five clear days before the day of hearing, and your notice must contain the particulars required by the rules of the Court. You must also, in any of the above cases, then deliver to the Registrar as many copies, as there are opposite parties, of the notice and particulars, and an additional one for the use of the Court. If your defence be a set-off, you must, within the same time, also deliver to the Registrar a statement of the particulars thereof. If your defence be a tender, you must pay into Court, before or at the hearing of the cause, the amount you allege to have been tendered.

Notice of defence cannot be received unless the fees for entering and transmitting the same be paid at the time the notices are given.

If the debt or claim exceed five pounds, you may have the cause tried by a jury, on giving notice thereof in writing at the said office of the Registrar, two clear days at least before the day of trial, and on payment of the fees for summoning, and payable to such jury.

Summonses for witnesses and the production of documents may be obtained at the Office of the Registrar.
