To all or any of the Constables, or other Peace Officers, in the said Province of British Columbia :

WHEREAS *Tom Keets-Ka-mum, a Saanich Indian, of Saanich, B.C.* - hath this day *September 18th A.D. 1884* -, been charged upon oath before the undersigned, *one* - of Her Majesty's Justices of the Peace, _____

in and for the said Province of British Columbia, for that he, on *the 25th day of February, A.D. 1884*, at or near the field of *one James Pollock*, situated on Cedar Hill Road, in Victoria District in said Province, did feloniously, wilfully and of his malice aforethought kill and murder *one No-ees, alias Old Jack, a Cowichan Indian*, against the Peace of Our Sovereign Lady the Queen, Her crown and dignity, by then and there striking the said *No-ees, alias Old Jack, a Cowichan Indian*, on the right side of his head with a shot-gun, thereby fracturing the skull of the said *No-ees, alias Old Jack, a Cowichan Indian*, contrary to the form of Statute in such case made and provided

These are therefore to command you, in Her Majesty's name, forthwith to apprehend the said *Tom Keets-Ka-mum, a Saanich Indian* and to bring him before *me* or some other of Her Majesty's Justices of the Peace in and for the said Province of British Columbia, to answer unto the said charge, and to be further dealt with according to law.
