### Warrant of Commitment.

CANADA.

PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA. }

District or County of *Yale*

To all or any of the Constables, or other Peace Officers, in the District or County of *Yale*, and to the Keeper of the Common Gaol of the District or County of *New Westminster* at *New Westminster*, in the said District or County of *British Columbia*.

WHEREAS *Indian Charley* was this day charged before *us* of Her Majesty's Justices of the Peace in and for the said District or County of *Province*, on the oath of *Indian*

*Jimmy*, and others, for that *to the said Indian "Charley" did unlawfully and maliciously cut, and did the said Deponent at the town of Yale, on the third day of March A. D. 1883.*

*"Pleas'd guilty"*

These are therefore to command you the said Constables or Peace Officers, or any of you, to take the said *Indian Charley* and him safely convey to the Common Gaol at *New Westminster* aforesaid, and there to deliver him to the Keeper thereof, together with this Precept; and *we* do hereby command you, the said Keeper of the said Common Gaol, to receive the said *Indian Charley* into your custody in the said Common Gaol, and there safely to keep him until he shall be thence delivered by due course of law.

GIVEN under *our* Hands and Seals, this *4th* day of *March*, in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and *eighty three*, at *New Westminster*, in the District or *Province* County aforesaid.
