



NOTICE—If you are desirous of contesting the validity of any judgment or order of the Court, you must deliver your contestation at any time before the day of appearing, subject to the payment of further costs.

If you and the Plaintiff can agree as to the amount due and the mode of payment, you may enter your contestation at any time before the day of appearing, subject to the payment of further costs, and no attendance at the Court is necessary.

# VANCOUVER ISLAND.

If you submit the whole or any part of the Plaintiff's claim, together with the costs, to the Registrar of the Court, at the Court House, Victoria, and if you pay in the clear days before the day of appearing, the Plaintiff shall prove a good and lawful claim, and you shall be bound to pay the amount of the same, unless you can prove to the satisfaction of the Court that you are entitled to a verdict in your favor.

## In the Supreme Court of Civil Justice,

HOLDEN AT VICTORIA  
If you intend to rely on as a defence a set-off, inquiry, counterclaim, or a statute of limitation, you must give notice thereof to the Registrar of the Court five clear days before the day of appearing, and you must also, in any of the above cases, deliver to the Registrar as many copies as there are opposites of the notice and particulars, and an affidavit as to the truth of the facts stated therein. If your defence be a set-off, you must pay into Court before the day of appearing the amount of the set-off, and you must also deliver to the Registrar a statement of the particulars thereof. If your defence be a tender, you must pay into Court before the day of appearing the amount of the tender.
