**“Princess Royal” and “Charmer” at Vancouver Harbour**

The “Charmer”, only 200 feet long, had a “romantic” and violent early history before entering Canadian service. Then, with a record of 3000 safe voyages before 1902, she operated reliably throughout the Gulf of Georgia until 1935. The Princess Royal, a wooden vessel with accommodations rivaling those of the Princess Victoria, was 70 feet shorter and a strictly general purpose vessel; comfortable in good weather. After a period of service on the Alaska run, she served in the Gulf of Georgia until 1934.
