Just a few lines to let you know that I am in barracks here now and will be here for about 2 months. There is about 4 ft of snow here and it is cold every day. There is about 10,000 people in this town and there is a lot of girls.

I was vaccinated about a week ago and my arm is all swelled up now.

Did you get my trunk. If you didn't, just write to the Y. M. C. A. at Victoria Barracks Calgary about it.

Nearly all the boys here

has a bad cold and some
of them has scarlet fever.
