Dear Sister -

I received your letter a few days ago and was surprised to hear that you had received no letters from me. No doubt mother has been withholding letters on you but you had better ask the postmaster to keep your letters until you call for them personally. Yes I've heard from W. G. he is in Bramshot Camp England

I expect he'll be over here before
very long. Well we've been having
some lovely weather over here and
the country looks very beautiful since
the leaves are out and blossoms on
the trees. What is Bill doing and
where is he I haven't heard from
him for over two months.

I got a letter from Martha about a
month ago but have not answered
it. She wanted me to send her my
trunk keys as she wanted to keep
my things for me but I don't
want her to have any thing to
do with my trunk or personal
things. If she has them already I want
you to let me know and I'll
stop her allowance if she doesn't
give them up and send them back
to where I had them kept. Anyhow
I've written to Jerry Talbot where
I had them stored and asked him

If they had been disturbed,
well I'm getting along
fine over here so don't
worry about me at all.
If you need any money
for clothes ask Willie to
give you some. He has a
little of my money yet.
Well I must close now
hope this will reach you
in good shape. & don't forget
to write soon.
