

THE ELECTRIC POWER HOUSE

Great Progress Being Made in All De-partments of the Work.

A member of THE LEDGER staff visited the electric light power house yesterday afternoon. Strong forces of bricklayers, masons, carpenters and machinists are engaged in doing their best to finish the building and put the engines together as quickly as possible. The big fly wheel was driving engine is being rapidly got ready for action. It is a beautiful piece of machinery and looks quite capable of supplying power for twice the service required.
