The authorities of the Agricultural Department at Ottawa are about to es-tablish a number of dairy schools, of which one or more will be located in each Province. This step is, it is under-stood, being taken on the advice of Professor Robertson, the Dominion Dairy Commissioner, who last autumn visited our city; and delivered a most interesting facture on the work of his department. and the agricultural possibilities of British Columbia. The chief object of the new movement is to bring about a very necessary general improvement in the quality of Canadian butter; and thus enable it, like Canadian cheese, to sup-ply not only the home market, but also ply not only the mome market, out also meet in part the growing demand in the United Kingdom for superior makes of butter. The dairy schools will however almost equally tend to raise the quality of our classes, much of which is not yet, as it might be, of the best. Professor Robertson thinks too, that the new novement will especially benefit Princ Edward's Island, where agriculture has lately been much depressed, partly as a result of the McKinley tariff. He believes this notwithstanding, that the island farmers can, by providing cheese and butter far superior to that now made, recoverall their former prosperity.
