DOMINION GENERAL ELECTION

To the Electors of New Westminster District.

Having been asked by an influential committee to allow myself to be put in nomination as a candidate at the forthcoming election to represent the farming, industrial and commercial interests of this large and important district, and believing that these and other interests could best be served by a representative, untrammelled by party lines, I have after due consideration, consented to nomination as an Independent candidate.

While not prepared to support unrestricted reciprocity, which would involve discrimination against the mother country, I believe that a thorough reform of the present tariff would be in the best interests of the Province and of our people.

I will insist upon a thorough investigation into the administration in this Province of the Land and Timber Departments, having reason to believe that its results have been chiefly the enrichment of speculators, and that it is adverse to the interests of bona fide manufacturers, farmers and intending settlers.

I would respectfully advocate greater representation for this district in this Province and insist on their exclusion from employment on Public Works.

The present fishery regulations are unjust and unnecessary. There should be no discrimination between the Fraser and the other rivers of the Province, and I would advocate that all fishermen making application should be granted fishing licenses at a nominal fee.

I will urge upon the Government the necessity of appropriating a much larger sum to improve the navigation of the Fraser, the Columbia and other rivers and the lighting and boating on the same.

Such railways, canals and bridges as would tend to open and develop the vast resources of this district and Province and promote the convenience of our people.

I will urge on the Government the necessity of taking over all uncompleted Indian reservations from the Indian Department and throwing them open to actual settlers.
