Dear Mr. Goldie:


I returned by the Olympis, arriving here on the 16th, and have your letter of the 9th with enclosed statement and copy of Warren's water agreement, also copy of the two water agreements with Maddock.

Two days before sailing I saw Mr. Dormer in London, who said he had completed his plans to sail by the Mauretania on the 18th. To-morrow evening I am returning to New York, and will probably be there until after Dormer's boat arrives. I am taking the copies of the water agreement down with me, and will try and go into them with Dormer. I will also go over the financial statement and see whether there is anything further to dig up.

Am trying to shape things so as to leave for British Columbia about the beginning of May, but will let you know as soon as I can definitely say.
