Dear Jim:-

I have your letter of the 4th with enclosed letter from E. Henderson the Coldstream Municipality Clerk which I return you herewith.

As you say the cost of a new irrigation system is a bad feature in connection with a right-of-way through Bellona but even worse than this is the splitting in two of the place which would deteriorate it for purposes of sale en bloc.

I don't know what the rights of expropriation of the Municipality are but should certainly think they would provide for any damage and depreciation.

I expect to be out there the latter part of November or the beginning of December so we may be able to do something then providing you have been unable to get an offer for the place before then.
