

Greenwood B.C. May 9<sup>th</sup> 1911

Dear Jim:-

We had more hard luck between Rainbow and Kelowna breaking a spring which delayed us two hours. After this however all went well except for missing the road two or three times so that we stayed in Osoville Sunday night and ran over here Monday morning. It is 54 miles from Oso to Greenwood via Chesaw & Molson and the road is good but the Molson hill a hard one. I paid the boy off at Midway and sent him back bringing the car up from there myself. The run down from Okanagan Falls to Osoville in the evening was delightful.

On my return I have your letter of Apr 28<sup>th</sup> re water agreement for Rainbow; this we arranged in comprence Saturday night and I now return you your letter to Warren and his to you of April 22<sup>nd</sup>

I also enclose you such of those Rainbow pictures as I have. Am sending photo of Bellevue to de Vesce.

Your letter of May 2<sup>nd</sup> re Bellevue affairs was also received and I return you as you request the Balance Sheet & Inventory I also return the Auditors statements for 1910 and 1911 which belong to the Rauche file. The latter is unsigned and is of no use except as a record to which you could not tie up.

On thinking over financing Bellevue I have thought that in order to save you worry I had better at once provide the money to meet all the outstanding debts of \$2361.47 as per your letter of May 5<sup>th</sup>. I am therefore sending today to the Royal Bank Vernon draft at par for \$2500 (two thousand five hundred) asking the manager to deposit this to my credit in a savings account and authorizing
