Dear Jim:-

Am sending the Royal Bank at Vernon today draft at par Vernon for two thousand dollars (\$2000.⁰⁰) with instructions to credit Rainbow with \$1200 and Bellevue with \$800. Of this latter amount am asking them to take up the note for \$500 and also the of placing the remainder to credit balance of the Bellevue a/c. You can check up the details when you are in Vernon and have things straightened up.

I will provide more money for Bellevue to balance all its outstanding up to April 30th as soon as you let me know what is required.

Am charging ^{ten} eight dollars travelling expenses from time of stopping off at Sicamous till leaving from there four of which I charge to Rainbow and six to Bellevue and enclose two receipts one to Rainbow for \$1204 and the other to Bellevue for \$806 which please sign and return. You had better sign the Bellevue receipt as agent and then make a cut-off of the Bellevue a/c to apl 30th as soon as you have the outstanding to your satisfaction starting with a clean sheet at May 1st. In figuring the liabilities you will of course have to take the interest on advances to May 1st into a/c.

Am very busy but if possible am going to try and get over for a day or two in the motor before going back East.

Hope to hear from you in a few days how you have made out in turning over Bellevue from Thomas.
