

Greenwood B.C. Aug 26th 1911

Dear Jim:-

We got through all night on Wednesday and have been very busy since. Will leave Tuesday morning Aug 29th for the East stopping Sept 2nd in St. Paul then to Toronto and St Catharines arriving in New York about Sept. 10th.

With this I am enclosing two or three copies of description of Bellevue for you to use or revise as you see fit and am also sending one to Mac Rae.

I am by this mail sending the Royal Bank draft at par for twelve hundred dollars (\$1200) to be applied \$900 to Bellevue and \$300 to Rainbow. Please sign the enclosed receipts and mail to me at 60 Wall St. N.Y. as soon as Mac Rae advises you of the deposit which I am asking him to do.

If you will write me to New York and let me know how much I still have to put up to bring my credit balance with Rainbow equivalent to Downers and yours I will send it the amount as soon as possible after my return to New York.

Good luck to you and I hope you can turn Bellevue soon.
