

Greenwood, June 12<sup>th</sup> 1912

Dear Jim:-

Coming into Peachland yesterday afternoon at three we found the road washed out and were delayed four hours. We went round by a sand hill and reached Summerland at eight only to find it impossible to get to Penticton. This took the heart out of us and we decided to stay there the night.

This morning we ferried back across the lake again to Naramatta and leaving there at nine came through sailing arriving Greenwood about 5:30 this afternoon.

Am leaving in the morning starting East and return you the letters you request re road through Bellevue.

We will arrange financing one way or other as soon as we hear from the Royal Bank.
