Yours of March 20th

*came duly to hand - we will get
your order off in day or two.*

*Regret to hear of your loss by spring
planting - you evidently got some of
a lot of Jonathan apple I imported
from an irrigated district, and about
all of them died - those I will credit
on your order - but I do not understand
your loss of peaches - as our heaviest loss
on stock we transplanted 16th of May was
16 pe which was on peaches. Cherries, it
is quite evident that there is very little
use planting trees in the dry belt ^{in spring} unless
cut back to a single stalk about 18 inches high
and free from alkali especially so for peaches
as they are more easily injured by alkali than
any other tree -*
